EASA Part-66 Exam Rules and Regulations

Instructions for Examination

1. You will be given time updates 20, 10, 5 and 2 minutes before the end of exam and you are requested to mark all answers within the given time and not to leave any answer unmarked even if it's a guess.
2. You will be given time updates; however, you are responsible yourself for managing your time and no extra time shall be granted irrespective of whether you've completed your examination or not.
3. Once the examiner calls "times-up", then you're supposed to leave your Tabs on the table irrespective of whether your exam is complete or not.
4. If you're caught doing anything with the tab or even it is found in your hand after examiner's call, then it will be considered as cheating.
5. Cheating, in any form, is strictly prohibited and if you're found to be looking around/ turning/ whispering, your examination will be cancelled and you may be asked to leave the hall.
6. The only place you are supposed to be looking is on your OWN question.
7. Signature in the attendance sheet is a must. Without signature your exam will not be catered and the examination will be void.
8. Taking any document related to examination out with yourself is a serious offence and will be dealt accordingly.
9. If fire alarm rings, you are supposed to leave by the nearest fire exit and leave everything on your desk.
